Packed Lunches

At Halsall, we're trying to encourage the children to think about Healthy Eating choices and also about conservation and the wider world, waste, recycling, global footprints etc.

Please provide a balanced lunch with a sandwich, maybe a yoghurt, piece of fruit, biscuit and a non-sugary drink, non-fizzy drink.

Please do not include any chocolate bars or sweets (this is not permitted). Please do not include any peanuts or Nutella sandwiches as we have several children in school with nut allergies.

Could we also ask that, if you're sending in a packed lunch, you try and reduce the amount of plastic that has to be thrown away. Thanks for your support with this matter.

Busy Car Park

On busy and wet mornings, the parking spaces for parents are soon full. Once full, parents will need to exit the car park and park out of the school grounds. Waiting for a space is not permitted as this causes further congestion.

Designated staff spaces must not be used by parents. Please use all the spaces available and do not block off spaces if you need to leave quickly. (especially at the far end of the car park or outside the nursery classroom)

Junior (only) children should now be using the drop-off to reduce congestion and release more spaces for parents of reception and KS1 children.

Parents parking inconsiderately or driving over the speed limit will be prohibited from using the car park. Please let us know if you have a concern.

Parking Outside School in the Community

I am sorry to say that we are regularly receiving calls from local residents in both Carr Moss Lane and Summerwood Lane, worried about inconsiderate and in some cases, dangerous parking. Sometimes vehicles are parked on pavements so pedestrians have to walk in the road, sometimes driveways are blocked, sometimes cars are double parked or parked crooked thus restricting the flow of traffic and sometimes children are being dropped off opening doors on to the roadside rather than the pavement. Some cars even ignore the legal restriction in Carr Moss Lane. If you witness any inconsiderate and dangerous parking, please report it to school asap so that we can speak to the people concerned. We want to keep everyone as safe as possible. Thanks.
